4 To the above named Defendant:

6 1. This action arises under the Constitution of the United States,  
7 Article V as hereinafter more fully appears.

8 2. Under the terms of Article V of the Constitution of the United  
9 States, the Congress of the United States in its official  
10 capacity is mandated and obligated, without discretion, upon the  
11 application of two-thirds of the several state legislatures, to  
12 call a convention to propose amendments to the Constitution of  
13 the United States.

14 3. As more than two-thirds of the several state legislatures have  
15 applied under Article V for a convention to propose amendments  
16 and this being the sole requirement necessary for such a  
17 convention to be called as specified in Article V of the  
18 Constitution of the United States, Congress, in its official  
19 capacity has not fulfilled this mandated and obligatory duty.  
20 Thus, it is in clear violation of Article V of the Constitution  
21 of the United States.

22 4. The refusal by Congress, in its official capacity, to call a  
23 convention to propose amendments, has violated several guaranteed  
24 constitutional rights of the plaintiff including his right to  
25 vote, right to associate, right to seek elected office, right of  
26 redress and right to alter or abolish. Further, such refusal is  
27 violation of the Constitution per se as well a violation of

1           several well established constitutional principals, chief among  
2           them the separation of powers doctrine.

3  
4           Wherefore the plaintiff demands judgment against Congress in the  
5           form of an order compelling them to call a convention to propose  
6           amendments as prescribed under Article V of the Constitution of the  
7           United States together with such other relief as the this Court may  
8           find appropriate.
